

## GOOD FAITH ESTIMATE WEBSITE NOTICE

Under Section 2799B-6 of the Public Health Service Act, the “No Surprises Act,” you have a right to receive a “good faith estimate” explaining how much your therapy services will cost. Healthcare providers are required to provide clients who do not have insurance or who choose not to use their insurance for therapy services with an estimate of the cost of those services. The total cost for each client will vary depending upon the length of time and frequency of sessions that occur throughout the therapeutic relationship as determined by the initial assessment and continued evaluation of treatment needs and progress. A detailed list of possible services is provided. This estimate will be valid for the next twelve (12) months. Should any fee changes occur, or upon your request, I/the practice will provide you with a new Good Faith estimate.
